

Media Release

The New South Wales Crime Commission has commenced asset confiscation proceedings under the Criminal Assets Recovery Act and has obtained an all interest restraining order pursuant to Section 10A of the Act.

On 23 May 2019 the NSW Crime Commission were successful in obtaining an all interest restraining order in the NSW Supreme Court against Damion Flower, effectively restraining all of his interests in property.

The NSW Crime Commission did not seek an order to seize any race horses, however the interests Mr Flower has in any race horse will be captured by the restraining order.
